The Intermountain Histories Internship is a PAID internship that earns student 3 elective BYU History credits. Interns gain valuable (and marketable) experience in digital and public history and some may be hired in subsequent semesters as Research and Editorial Assistants for the project – another great line on your CV/Resume.
