Devereux Butcher, publisher and editor of the National Wildlands News, a newspaper advocating for conserving nature, attacked Udall for his acceptance of multiple use in the proposed park. Allowing commercial activity in Canyonlands would violate traditional park values and set a dangerous example. Udall, he said, should be praised for his "enthusiasm for new parks," but his allowance of multiple use "was going too far."
